#### About the Cover

Kylemore Castle was built in 1868 as a private home for the family of Mitchell Henry, a wealthy doctor from London whose family was involved in textile manufacturing in Manchester, England. He moved to Ireland when he and his wife Margaret purchased the land around the Abbey, after having travelled there on their honeymoon in the mid 1840s. He became a politician, becoming an MP for County Galway from 1871 to 1885. The castle was designed by James Franklin Fuller, aided by Usher Roberts. The construction of the castle began in 1867, and took the total of one hundred men and four years to complete. The castle covered approximately 40,000 square feet (3,700 m2) and had over seventy rooms with a principal wall that was two to three feet thick. There were 33 bedrooms, 4 bathrooms, 4 sitting rooms, a ballroom, billiard room, library, study, school room, smoking room, gun room and various offices and domestic staff residences for the butler, cook, housekeeper and other servants. Other buildings include a Gothic church and family mausoleum containing the bodies of Margaret Henry, Mitchell Henry and a great grand-nephew.

The Abbey remained in Henry's estate after he returned to England. The castle was sold to the Duke and Duchess of Manchester in 1903, who resided there for several years before being forced to sell the house and grounds because of gambling debts. In 1920, the Irish Benedictine Nuns purchased the Abbey castle and lands after they were forced to flee Ypres during World War I. The nuns, who had been based in Ypres for several hundred years, had been bombed out of their Abbey during World War I. At the Abbey the nuns offered education to Catholic girls, opening an international boarding school and establishing a day school for girls from the locality. The school acted as the main educator for most girls from Renvyle, Letterfrack and further afield for almost a century but it was forced to close in June 2010. The nuns have since been developing new education and retreat activities. Since 2015, the Abbey has entered a partnership with the University of Notre Dame. The abbey hosts academic programs for Notre Dame students, and the university renovated spaces in the abbey.

The Estate includes large walled Victorian Gardens. Since the 1970s these have been open for public tours and 'nature' walks. The Benedictine community has restored the Abbey's gardens and church with donations and local artisans in order to be a self-sustaining estate.

"My commitment to putting citizens and community first will always be my top priority. I will provide the service and representation citizens deserve and expect. Glen Hill was born in New Bern, NC. After graduating from high school, he joined the U.S. Army. His last tour of duty was Vint Hill Farms Station on the western border of Prince William County, where he served in the U.S. Army Security Agency. He received an Honorable Discharge from the U.S. Army in June 1969. Following his discharge, he became the first African-American to join the Manassas Police Department. While serving there, he continued his education in Criminal Justice at Northern Virginia Community College.

In January of 1982, he joined the newly created Prince William-Manassas Regional Adult Detention Center, where he held every management position, including appointment to Superintendent in 1993. While serving as jail superintendent, he was named Correctional Administrator of the Year for 1997 by the American Jail Association.

#### SHERIFF GLEN HILL (CONT.)

In November 2003, he was elected Sheriff of Prince William County and is currently serving as Chairman for the Prince William-Manassas Regional Jail Board. Sheriff Hill has more than five decades (50 years) of law enforcement experience in Manassas City and Prince William County. In November 2019, he was re-elected to serve his fifth term.

Sheriff Hill has received several awards including the following:

- Correctional Administrator of the Year, American Jail Association (1997)
- Lifetime Professional Achievement Commendation, Virginia House of Delegates
- Outstanding Support and Service Recognition, United States Marshals Service
- Prince William County Republican of the Year, Prince William County Republic Committee (2003)

Glen and his wife, Carolyn, have been married since 1974. They have three children, ten grandchildren and four great grandchildren. Carolyn is a school teacher in the City of Manassas School System.

We thank Sheriff Hill for his many years of public service and for his annual participation in, and support of the Manassas St. Patrick's Day Parade.

#### HISTORY OF ST. PATRICK

t. Patrick of Ireland is one of the world's most popular saints. He was born in Roman Britain and when he was 14 or so, he was captured by Irish pirates during a raiding party and taken to Ireland as a slave to herd and tend sheep. Patrick's captivity lasted until he was 20, when he escaped after having a dream in which he was told by God to leave Ireland by going to the coast. There he found some sailors who took him back to Britain and he was reunited with his family.

A few years after returning home, Patrick saw a vision he described in his memoir: "I saw a man coming, as it were from Ireland. His name was Victoricus, and he carried many letters, and he gave me one of them. I read the heading: 'The Voice of the Irish.' As I began the letter, I imagined in that moment that I heard the voice of those very people who were near the wood of Foclut, which is beside the western sea, and they cried out, as with one voice: 'We appeal to you, holy servant boy, to come and walk among us.'"




The vision prompted his studies for the priesthood. He was ordained by St. Germanus, the Bishop of Auxerre, whom he had studied under for years, and was later ordained a bishop and sent to take the Gospel to Ireland.

Patrick arrived in Slane, Ireland on March 25, 433. There are several legends about what happened next, with the most prominent claiming he met the chieftan of one of the druid tribes, who tried to kill him. However, Patrick was able to convert the chieftain and preach throughout Ireland. There, he converted many people, eventually thousands, and he began building churches across the country.

He often used shamrocks to explain the Holy Trinity and entire kingdoms were eventually converted to Christianity after hearing Patrick's message. Patrick preached in Ireland for 40 years. After years of living in poverty, traveling and enduring much suffering, he died March 17, 461. He died at Saul, where he had built the first Irish church. He is believed to be buried in Down Cathedral, Downpatrick. His grave was marked in 1990 with a granite stone.
